



## TODDLER CLASSROOM SCHEDULE

Bathroom breaks are incorporated throughout the school day. The children learn to go independently.

<b>Time</b>	<b>Activity</b>
<b>8:10-8:25am</b>	<b>Arrival</b> - Carline
8:30-9:30am	<b>Morning Work Cycle</b> - Toddlers receive practical life lessons (cooking, baking, food prep, dish washing, window washing, spooning, tonging, selfcare and hygiene, care of the environment and gardening).
9:30-10:00am	<b>Morning Snack</b> - The children learn how to wash, cut and serve fruits and vegetables, and set the tables. This encourages healthy eating and independence.
10:00-10:30am	<b>Morning Circle</b> - This is a special part of the day when toddlers come together as a community to enjoy stories, say a simple prayer, sing songs, and engage in fun music and movement activities. This shared experience helps build social connections, encourages participation, and supports early language and motor development in a warm, engaging environment.
10:45-11:20am	<b>Outdoor Time</b> - Developing gross motor skills and social skills.
11:20-11:30am	<b>Handwashing lesson.</b>
11:30-12:00pm	<b>Lunch</b> - The children eat in a family like setting, encouraging table etiquette and grace and courtesy.
<b>12:00pm</b>	<b>Morning dismissal - Children under 2 years (Nido)</b>
12:00-2:00pm	<b>Nap and rest time.</b>
2:00-2:45pm	<b>Afternoon Circle</b> – This is a calm and reflective closing time that provides an opportunity to reflect on the day's experiences and helps ensure a peaceful departure. Activities include sharing highlights from the day, listening to stories, prayer, and farewell songs.
<b>2:45-3:00pm</b>	<b>Dismissal</b> - Carline
